NOTICE OF THE BOARD

Mr. Kerr-Wilson, counsel for the objectors Bell Canada, Google, Quebecor Media, Rogers, Shaw, Spotify, and CBC, raises the issue that some of these objectors are prevented from taking certain actions in relation to Re:Sound's proposed Tariff 8, by virtue of the Board's Order 2017-126. Mr. Kerr-Wilson is concerned that he would not be able to take those actions at all, and proposes modifications to the Order.

First, the parties are reminded that both users and non-users of a tariff may seek intervenor status.

Second, the requested modifications by Mr. Kerr-Wilson are not necessary; limitations referred to in Order 2017-126 are directed at parties. Counsel whose clients include both parties that objected to Re:Sound's proposed Tariff 8 and parties that did not will nevertheless be able to pose interrogatories to Re:Sound, cross-examine witnesses appearing solely on behalf of Re:Sound, and file evidence relevant only in relation to Tariff 8—but only on behalf of the parties that did object to that tariff.
