Subject: Proposed Schedule for Remainder of 2014-18 TV Retransmission Proceeding

Mr. McDougall,

I am pleased to report that the parties to the 2014-18 TV retransmission proceeding have now agreed to propose the schedule set out below to the Board for its consideration and, hopefully, approval. The parties who have agreed are the BDUs and the following collectives: CCC, CBRA, CRC, CRRRA, FWS, MLB, BBI, DRTVC and SOCAN. Representatives of these parties are copied on this email.

Subject to the two notes provided below, the parties request that the following schedule be approved by the Board:

- April 30, 2015 – Collectives file final responses to BDU Interrogatories
- May 8, 2015 – Collectives file their Statement(s) of Case and Evidence
- September 1, 2015 – BDUs file Notice setting out names of witnesses and general description of issues to be addressed by each
- September 30, 2015 - BDUs file their Statement of Case and Evidence

- November 6, 2015 - Collectives file their Reply to BDU Case and Evidence
- November 23, 2015 – Tentative Date for Commencement of Hearing

The proposed schedule is subject to the following notes:

- (1) It is understood that the Board may reserve final approval of the hearing commencement date until a later time, and that the November 23rd hearing date will remain tentative until it is confirmed by the Board; and
- (2) Since the US Thanksgiving holiday takes place during the last half of the first week of the hearing (week of November 23rd), the parties have agreed that, subject to the Board's approval, they will cooperate to schedule evidence at the hearing so that US witnesses will be scheduled to appear before and after, but not during, the holiday period.
