Dear Mr. McDougall,

I write on behalf of Access Copyright to request a one-week extension of the time to file Access Copyright's case in the Post-Secondary Educational Institutions Tariff (2011-2013) & (2014-2017).

The reason that Access Copyright is making this request is because of conflicting commitments of two of its expert witnesses that have caused a short delay in the production of their reports.

Mr. Maguire has agreed to not oppose our request provided that he is also granted an additional week to file his responding case. Access Copyright agrees to truncate its time for reply so that all materials will be filed with the Board by December 18 in accordance with the original schedule. As such, this extension should have no effect on the January 19, 2016 hearing date.

We therefore request that the schedule set out in the Board's Notice of July 15, 2015 be amended as follows:

- Access Copyright to file its case no later than **Friday, November 6, 2015**
- Mr. Maguire to file his case no later than **Friday, December 4, 2015**
