NOTICE OF THE BOARD

In Notice 2017-167 the Board identified the following proposed tariffs to be considered in the above-mentioned proceeding:

Re:Sound

- Tariff 1.A – Commercial Radio (2015-2017, 2018-2020)
- Tariff 8 – Simulcasting and Webcasting (2009-2012) [commercial radio simulcasting portion only]
- Tariff 8 – Simulcasting, Non-Interactive Webcasting and Semi-Interactive Webcasting (2013, 2014, 2015) [commercial radio simulcasting portion only]
- Tariff 1.A.2 – Commercial Radio Simulcasts (2016-2017)

SOCAN

- Tariff 1.A – Commercial Radio (2014, 2015, 2016, 2017, 2018)
- Tariff 22.3 – Webcasts of Radio Station Signals (2007, 2008) [commercial radio simulcasting portion only]
- Tariff 22.C – Webcasts of Radio Station Signals (2009, 2010, 2011, 2012, 2013) [commercial radio simulcasting portion only]
- Tariff 22.B – Commercial Radio, Satellite Radio, and Pay Audio (2014, 2015, 2016, 2017, 2018) [commercial radio simulcasting portion only]

On January 12, 2018, in their responses Re:Sound, SOCAN, and CAB confirmed their intent to participate in the above-mentioned proceeding and agreed to the proposed consolidation. No other party (listed in the Annex to Notice 2017-167) confirmed its intent to participate in the proceeding and as such they are deemed to have withdrawn.

Given that the Parties agree to the proposed consolidation, the tariffs that will be considered in this proceeding are those listed above.

Negotiation period

In their response, Re:Sound, with the consent of SOCAN and CAB, requested a 6-month settlement period to negotiate a resolution to all or some of the issues in dispute. This request is hereby granted. Parties shall report back to the Board by no later than **Friday, July 20, 2018**.

If Parties have not reached an agreement by that date, the Board intends to commence the proceedings immediately. To that end, Parties shall file with the Board, by no later than **Friday, February 2, 2018**, a joint proposed schedule of proceedings that will take effect at the end of the 6-month settlement period.
