RULING OF THE BOARD

On October 27, 2017, CMRRA filed a notice of withdrawal of its proposed *Audiovisual Services Tariff, 2016-2018* (“Tariff 7”).

On December 15, 2017, Bell Canada, Canadian Broadcasting Corporation, Google (no longer an objector), Rogers Communications, Quebecor Media, Shaw Communications, Canadian Cable Systems Alliance, Cogeco, Entertainment Software Association of Canada, TELUS Communication, Canadian Association of Broadcasters, Netflix, and Stingray wrote to the Board, stating that they do not oppose CMRRA’s request to withdraw Tariff 7.

The remaining objectors to this proposed tariff, being Apple, the Fitness Industry of Canada (no longer an objector), GoodLife (no longer an objector), the Motion Picture Association – Canada, and Videotron, did not submit comments on the proposed withdrawal.

On February 27, 2018, CMRRA requested that the Board suspend the Timetable the Board established for these proceedings in Notice 2017-139, as it applies to Tariff 7.

CMRRA’s request is granted. The Timetable, as it applies to Tariff 7, is suspended, until further notice from the Board.
