NOTICE OF THE BOARD - *Erratum*

File: CBC Radio and Simulcasts (2009-2020) / SRC – Radio et diffusion simultanée (2009-2020)

The Board intends to consider in a single proceeding the proposed tariffs that are applicable to CBC for the public performance and reproduction of musical works and sound recordings by over-the-air radio, and any simulcast thereof.

As such, the Board intends to commence forthwith proceedings in reference to the following proposed tariffs (the “Proposed Tariffs”):

Proposed Tariffs	Remarks
SOCAN	
SOCAN Tariff 1.C (<i>SOCAN-Re:Sound CBC Radio Tariff</i>) (2015, 2016, 2017, 2018)	Tariff 1.C applies to both over-the-air radio broadcasting and simulcasting of an over-the-air radio signal.
Re:Sound	
Re:Sound Tariff No. 1.C (<i>Re:Sound CBC Radio Tariff</i>) (2012, 2013-2016, 2017-2019)	These proposed tariffs do not apply to simulcasts of CBC radio for the years 2012, and 2013-2016; they do apply to such simulcasts for 2017-2019.
Re:Sound Tariff 8 (<i>NRCC Simulcasting and Webcasting Tariff, 2009-2012</i>) [simulcast of CBC radio only]	The Board certified this tariff on May 17, 2014, but excluded certain simulcasts—including simulcasts of CBC radio—from its application. The remaining portion applicable to CBC will be considered in these proceedings.
Re:Sound Tariff 8 (<i>Re:Sound Simulcasting, Non-Interactive Webcasting and Semi-Interactive Webcasting Tariff</i>) (2013, 2014, 2015) [simulcast of CBC radio only]	Only the portion of these proposed tariffs applicable to simulcasts of CBC radio will be considered in these proceedings.

Re:Sound Tariff No. 1.C.2 (<i>Canadian Broadcasting Corporation (CBC) Simulcasts</i>) (2016)	Prior to 2016, Tariff 8 applies to simulcasts of CBC radio. After 2016, Tariff 1.C applies to simulcasts of CBC radio.

<i>ARTISTI-CBC Tariff, 2015-2017</i> [excluding “webcasting activities on the webradios of Espace.Mu”]	The proposed tariff appears to apply to webcasting by CBC on its espace.mu site; that portion is excluded from consideration in these proceedings.
<i>Artisti-CBC Tariff, 2018-2020</i> [excluding “webcasting activities on its webradios”]	The proposed tariff appears to apply to webcasting by CBC; that portion is excluded from consideration in these proceedings.

Any collective that has filed any of the Proposed Tariffs, and any person that has objected to any of these tariffs (collectively, the “Parties”) may comment by no later than **Wednesday, March 7, 2018**, on the proposed consolidation including on the addition or removal of a proposed tariff, or component thereof, from this proceeding.

By no later than **Wednesday, March 21, 2018**, the Parties shall submit a proposed Schedule of Proceedings, either jointly or separately, for which the Board encourages the Parties to include a 3-month negotiation period.

If the Parties are unable to come to an agreement, the consideration of the Proposed Tariffs will follow the approved Schedule.
