## **NOTICE OF THE BOARD**

The Board intends to commence forthwith proceedings in reference to the proposed tariffs listed below (the “Proposed Tariffs”).

- SOCAN Tariff 22.H: Internet – Other Uses of Music – Game Sites (2013); and
- SOCAN Tariff 22.G: Internet – Other Uses of Music – Game Sites (2014, 2015, 2016, 2017, 2018, 2019).
