UNLOCATABLE COPYRIGHT OWNER

Non-exclusive licence issued to Ambassadors for Christ Ministries Inc., White City, Saskatchewan, authorizing the mechanical reproduction of four musical works

Pursuant to the provisions of subsection 77(1) of the *Copyright Act*, the Copyright Board grants a licence to Ambassadors for Christ Ministries Inc., as follows:

(1) The licence authorizes the mechanical reproduction of the following four musical works, for which the authors and composers are unknown, to the extent that the works have been published:

- *A Wonderful Man – Okunrin Iyanu;*
- *What shall we say unto the Lord;*
- *Praise the Lord, Halle;* and,
- *Awesome God, mighty God.*

No more than 500 copies of the works will be reproduced on CD.


The issuance of the licence does not release the licensee from the obligation to obtain permission for any other use not covered by this licence.

(2) The licence is valid from September 17, 2015 to November 30, 2025. The authorized reproduction must therefore be completed by that date.

(3) The licence is non-exclusive and valid only in Canada. For other countries, it is the law of that country that applies.

(4) The licensee will pay the sum of \$174.30 to the Canadian Musical Reproduction Rights Agency (CMRRA) for the mechanical reproduction rights. CMRRA will dispose of the amount as it sees fit for the general benefit of its members. CMRRA undertakes to reimburse any person, who establishes, before November 30, 2030, ownership of the copyright in the works covered in this licence.

(5) The coming into force of this licence is conditional on CMRRA's filing with the Board a Notice of Receipt of Payment and Undertaking which confirms that the royalties, as specified in paragraph (4) have been received and that CMRRA undertakes to comply with the conditions set out in same.
